

How to ... Enable Leuven Scale Assessments

Notes: Leuven Scales were developed by a team based at the Research Centre for Experiential Education (Leuven University – Belgium) under the supervision of Dr. Ferre Laevers.

The tool focuses on two central indicators of quality early years provision: children's 'well-being' and 'involvement'. Well-being refers to feeling at ease, being spontaneous and free of emotional tensions and is crucial to good 'mental health'. It is also linked to self-confidence, a good degree of self-esteem and resilience.

Involvement refers to being intensely engaged in activities and is considered to be a necessary condition for deep level learning and development.

In Tiny Tracker, you can add a Leuven Scale Assessment in conjunction with your other curriculum observations.
